School success starts with attendance

Every student thinks critically, is honest, has integrity and shows compassion and kindness

During this term we have some amazing learning lined up for our students. Along with learning in the classroom we also have a tennis coach visiting the school most weeks to work on tennis skills and performance. This term we will also be participating in swimming as the Physical Education component of the subject area HPE. Please note that this is a required part of the curriculum and students will be assessed on their swimming participation, effort and achievement at their current year level. Please see the "Dates to Note" for swimming days. An information and permission letter will come home shortly.

Our P&C has donated considerable funds for swimming which the school uses to pay for 4 qualified swimming instructors. Having 4 instructors allows us to cater for individual students swimming abilities and to reduce the number of students in each group, thus allowing more time for each student in direct swimming instruction and further reduces the costs to families for swimming lessons. Thank you to our P&C.

Next week we farewell our year 4, 5, and 6s off to camp. Our Campers are looking forward to a week filled with challenges and team building on the Sunshine Coast with our fellow campers from Jambin State School. The Prep to year 3 students are looking forward to having the whole playground to themselves for the week.

I am currently looking at enrolments, staffing, classes and the budget in preparation for 2022. Families who have indicated that they will have a kindy aged student enrolling in Kindy in 2022 are invited to a Kindy information session and enrolment on Monday 15 November at the school at 9am.

Families with students starting prep next year are encouraged to collect and complete an enrolment form now so Becky in our office can commence the enrolment process. Prep 2022 students are invited along to our transition morning to assist with making them comfortable and familiar with our school, classes and teachers. 

GROW, GRAZE, GIVE



Our year 3 to 6 students are participating in a school initiative to redesign the old garden area and create new sustainable gardens that will produce edible produce to be used for classroom learning, the tuckshop and student council meal deals. The students garden designs were pitched to the principal and teachers and a decision was made combining the features of a few designs to create the final 'blueprint'

for the garden. The garden beds have arrived and we are looking for some helpers to assist in constructing the raised garden beds. As there are 10 all up even if you can assist in putting one together this would be a massive help and the students would be most appreciative. The sooner the beds are together the soon the students can begin planting.

2022 CLASSES

Next year will see a change to our classes. In consultation with the P&C we have approved the re-introduction of 3 classes to cater for our kindy students. The model will be as follows:

Kindy will run on Monday and Tuesday during Semester One and Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday during Semester Two. Mrs Debbie O'Shae has been secured as our Kindy Teacher-Aide for next year and we are looking forward to having Debbie join our team.

Mrs Sandra Wass will join us on Wednesdays to teach Health and provide Principal Administration Day and non-contact time for teachers.

We continue to provide Japanese lessons via Distance Education for all year levels.

Miss Jo and Mrs Chad will continue as teacher aides assisting teachers and students in classrooms and Mrs Saunders will continue to teach music one afternoon a week.

A flexible 'at home' kindergarten program, with online support from a qualified early childhood teacher.



You can register for eKindy if:

- Your child turns 4 by June 30 in their Kindergarten year
- Your child/parent is an Australian citizen or a permanent resident of Australia
- You fit one of the following categories:
- · Distance live at least 16km from the nearest centre-based service across
- . Medical your child is unable to attend acentre-based service due to a medical
- Travellina/Itinerant lifestule awau from mainresidence for more than 10 weeks OR residence will change twice in a uear.

What is eKindy?

eKindy is a an approved Kindergarten program for children in the year prior to Prep.

The eKindyprogram offers a quality Kindergarten experience, supported by a qualified early childhood teacher and is designed for children living in rural/remote areas or have medical

The eKindy program

eKindy helps build the foundation skills, understandings and positive approaches to learning that are needed for future success.

The eighteKindy units have been developed to cover important learnings identified by current early years research and curriculum documents.

Parents have an active role and help the teacher with their child's learning. The program is flexible and can be worked through in ways that meet family and work commitments. The eKindy teacher can provide advice on how to manage

eKindy teacher-led sessions

During the year eKindy children participate in on-line sessions with an early childhood teacher. Opportunities to attend scheduled regional face-to-face sessions
