Improve the literacy achievements of students - with an explicit focus on reading.

- 80% students achieving at or above Literacy continuum cluster in Aspects of reading and comprehension. Improve students' literacy achievement by identifying the reading demands across the curriculum
- 80% Year 3 in U2B for Reading
- 80% Year 5 in U2B for Reading
- Relative Gain similar to or better than the Nation in Reading

Our initiatives include

- Develop a shared understanding of DATA literacy and to effectively use data to inform teaching of reading.
- Professional development and support teacher aides to consolidate student learning in reading.
- Update WSS reading program and embed across school.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Develop and implement a whole school approach to teaching reading aligned to Australian curriculum and including engagement with the Literacy indicators.
- Provide TRS to release teachers to develop programs identifying next steps required for learning.
- Employ additional teacher aide to work with marker students.
